O Holy Child of Bethlehem!

O little town of Bethlehem, how still we see thee lie!

Above thy deep and dreamless sleep the silent stars go by;

Yet in thy dark streets shineth the everlasting Light;

The hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee to-night.

O holy Child of Bethlehem! Descend to us, we pray; Cast out our sin, and enter in, be born in us to-day. We hear the Christmas angels the great glad tidings tell; Oh, come to us, abide with us, Our Lord Emmanuel!

This wonderful hymn was written by Phillip Brooks following a horseback journey from Jerusalem to Bethlehem on Christmas Eve. During its long history Jerusalem has been destroyed twice, besieged 23 times, attacked 22 times and captured 44 times and the Holy Land continues to be a place of conflict in our own day. This Christmas is probably closer to the original feeling of the Christmas Narrative. At a time of Roman occupation vulnerable individuals being ordered around when housing was at a crisis and the future unclear. Our own Christmases surely take up some of these themes.

Thank you to all who reach out to others in this Holy season, and nothing is holier than discovering that God is with us when we are up against it. The themes of Advent are about looking forward and a series of new beginnings being born in every community and in every heart as we look for them. We think about the children of today but don't forget the children who have grown old many of our older Australian had much simpler hopes for Christmas than the current generation. Their Christmas lists were much more modest. Think of the orange in the Christmas stocking, rather than a huge TV and the latest iPhone. The horse and the reindeer have probably bolted on managing consumer expectations but maybe we could think about doing things in a more connected way, thinking about kindness and others particularly when some of our seniors struggle to communicate and to keep in touch. Perhaps we could help them to reconnect with some special people in their lives at Christmas and share memories about being cared for, being special and valued.

The children of St Matthew's with our brides and community members are our greatest Christmas treasure. Please be in touch if you know of an older person who would appreciate a visit or a card from us and we will be glad to step forward. If you know someone who is isolated or needing special support, we will see if we can find a Christian Angel from St Matthew's to come to a series of rescues.



Next meeting: Wednesday 6th December from 1-4 pm.






